# HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

- Consider fire safety when decorating, do not overload electrical outlets with holiday lighting or special effects.
- Check around your property for low tree limbs, overgrown shrubs, support wires or garden hoses that may prove hazardous.



- Plan ahead to make and or purchase costumes that are bright and reflective. Make sure that shoes fit well and that costumes are short enough to prevent tripping or entanglement.
